

The India Satcom 2018 focusing on the theme “Mainstreaming Satcom - Connecting the Unconnected” begins today. The two-day conference organised by the Broadband India Forum would dwell on leveraging existing as well as next-generation satellite communication technologies to expedite the penetration of affordable broadband in India, particularly in the remote and rural areas complimentary to other broadband technologies such as optical fibre, mobile, cable etc. The conference would also deliberate on policy and regulatory measures required to facilitate rapid and barrier-free deployment of next-generation satellite communications technologies to achieve the socio-economic objectives of the government’s flagship programmes such as Digital India and Make in India.

The event being held on 20th and 21st November 2018 at Le Meridien in New Delhi will host several informative sessions addressed by eminent speakers. It will provide a platform to international delegates, speakers, representatives from the national diaspora and other stakeholders to engage in meaningful deliberations. The knowledge sessions being held during the event would aim to deliberate and formulate strategies related to - India 2020: economic potential of the satellite and broadcasting sector; affordability of satcom bandwidth - key to enable Digital India; CXO round table with policy makers; next-generation satellite technologies and applications in Satcom - LEO, MEO, HTS, connected cars, IFC, maritime applications, etc; next-generation satellite services for delivery of 5G and M2M/IoT and ease of doing business in satellite and broadcasting, amongst others.
